ABILITY TO SWIM - NO WAKA AMA EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

Water safety is a priority in Waka ama and facilitators of this programme. Waka ama has guidelines around safety developed in collaboration with Maritime Safety.

Students must demonstrate the ability to keep calm under pressure, have a reasonable level of confidence in the water and be comfortable in this environment.

Instruction by way of demonstration off and on water will be provided to students during programme to ensure they are able to handle a capsise situation if the waka overturns.
