

W1 Sprint Regionals Area Plan

In order to keep our competitors, coaches, club representatives and supporters safe please make sure that you have a read of the following information. Henley Lake is a public area and in order for us to run and manage this event under the current Level 2 restrictions we will ask that anyone participating, volunteering or supporting this event sticks within our laid-out boundaries so that bubbles are not mixed and so that the public still has access to the lake.

1: Parking

All cars will need to be parked in the field area to the right as you drive through the main gates of Henley Lake. If you are dropping off waka, we ask that you follow the road around and drop the waka off at the designated waka rigging area.

2: Waka Rigging Area

This area will be quite busy and to keep our paddlers safe, we ask that access to the waka rigging area be restricted to those that absolutely need to be there, ie paddlers, club representatives and intermediate support people only. We ask that once you have dropped your waka off, the vehicle is removed immediately and parked in area 1.

3: Sign In/Registration Area

We will have a set up area closer to the big sheds rather than the toilet block this year so that we aren't using up the pathway space, and to provide easier access to those in the waka rigging area. Please make sure that when you come to sign in/hand in waiver forms that you also bring along your proof of vaccination (eg COVID-19 vaccination certificate, see https://mycovidrecord.health.nz/).

4: Paddler/Club Reps Area

This area will be cordoned off for our paddlers and club reps, we ask that you do not leave the grass area and head towards the carpark/finish line area during the races, just so that we minimize the risk of our race bubble being mixed with the public.

5: Finish Line

We will have a caravan and volunteers set up at the finish line. We ask that any whanau supporters that end up staying to watch the races stay clear of this area and move right over to the other side of the lake.

RED ARROW: WE ASK THAT NO PADDLERS/CLUB REPRESENTATIVES ARE IN THIS AREA DURING EITHER SESSION, THIS CAR PARK SHOULD ONLY BE USED BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

We are strongly discouraging spectators at this event but realise that we are also holding it in a public space. If you have got spectators coming, we ask that they are watching from the far side of the lake and we encourage them to socially distance and wear a mask.
